


Life Leadership: “The Pentathlon”

10 Truths of biblical time/life management

1. The most important principle of time/life management is James 4:7: “Submit yourselves therefore to God.”
2. Time/life management is an act of worship to God.
3. All of life is spiritual and all of life matters to God.
4. There is no division between sacred and secular, preacher and plumber.
5. Life is not divided into hierarchies (God first, family second, church third, etc.). He wants to be Lord of it *all*.
6. There is no conflict of duty in Christian experience. God will not call you to be two places at once.
7. The portions of your “life pie” will be served in varying amounts, depending on your stage of life. The goal is not 20-20-20-20-20, but to submit each stage of life to God.
8. Your value is not determined by your work, but your work is valuable.
9. God values your leisure, hobbies and vacations and wants to be a part of them with you. Our recreational activities can and should honor him.
10. Our life is not our own, we were bought with a price. No area is off limits to God.
